The fishing area of Poussunkoski is approximately 1,5 km long, out of which around 400 meters are rapids. The Poussunjoki river runs from the lake Iijärvi and its location on the water route between large lakes gives its own addition to the fishery. Whitefish schools and singular brown trouts move from the lakes to the river and the grayling population is healthy. Trout is a fairly common catch thanks to the plantation of fish. There are good parking space and campsites next to the rapids. Poussunkoski offers great grounds; a 100-meter-long fishing pier is suitable also for those seeking for wheelchair accessible destinations. There is also a big shed for dining with a campfire site accessible for fishermen. The boat ramp is built with wheelchair-users in mind.

Soivio's quickly running parts are located along the same water route below Poussunjärvi lake. The part is around one-kilometer-long and it has about 200 meters of rapids. Both fast-running parts are short and between them is a few hundred meters long slowly running quiet water. The stream is easily achievable from the road Lehtomannisen tie.
